

## DRESS CODE RULES

When in the main bowls hall, members shall at all times conform to the following standards of dress when playing, marking or umpiring.

Grey, brown, black or predominantly white shoes that have no heels and are manufactured for lawn bowling.

These shoes must be used exclusively for bowling and must not be worn to enter the premises.

Plain grey or white trousers or skirts, or tailored shorts, according to the requirements of the competition.

Black trousers, cargo style trousers, leggings or grey or coloured jeans are not acceptable!

Any of the following shirts:

All shirts must have a collar.

Plain white shirt.

Predominantly white shirt manufactured by a Bowls Clothing Company.

Regulation P&DIBC shirts.

Team shirt approved by the club Committee as long as the same is worn by all team members.

County or other team regulation shirt as long as the same is worn by all team members.

Pullovers/sweaters/jackets must be predominantly white.

Team shirts from other clubs should not be worn unless playing on their behalf.

Tee shirts and sweat Shirts are not acceptable.
