

## COACHING

The Club has a number of qualified coaches. Coaching sessions are held on Saturday mornings throughout the winter season and outdoors during June and July, for both juniors and adults. Alternative times can be arranged with the coaching team. There is a minimal cost for attending coaching sessions, which are open to members and non members. All equipment is provided.

## PARTIALLY SIGHTED & LEARNING DISABLED

A session is run on Thursday evenings for the partially sighted. Once or twice a year this group play matches against similar opposition from other clubs.

On Friday mornings a group of learning disabled have a session on the back rinks.

## LOCKERS

There is a facility to store bowls equipment e.g. woods and shoes in metal lockers in the changing rooms. There is a small annual fee and details can be obtained from the Secretary.

## CAR PARKING

There is a large car park at the bowls club. Whilst every effort is made to make this a secure area, cars are parked at the owners risk. The club cannot be held liable for any damage caused to cars parked in this area.

## SOCIAL EVENTS

There is a fully licensed bar open seven days a week lunchtimes and evenings.
